

Field Fire & Rescue is looking to replace the vehicle that is currently used to respond to highway rescue related incidents.

Our budget for this vehicle replacement is not sufficient to purchase a new vehicle and as such we would like to know if there are any departments across Canada with a used vehicle that would be suitable for response to highway rescue incidents within a mountainous environment.

The preferred vehicle would have:

- a Ford F-550 or GMC 5500 type chassis with 4WD capability
- diesel engine with a healthy GVW rating
- available seating for 5 firefighters
- ample storage capacity for a full array of road rescue equipment
- at least one compartment capable of storing a Stokes litter
- we would also prefer the vehicle to have a small pump/tank/CAF system or ability to retrofit with pump and tank

Our department would be willing to look at retrofitting any existing vehicle that may suit our needs. We would also be willing to arrange for pick-up/delivery anywhere in Canada.
