The City of Regina, Fire and Protective Services Department has openings for a Fire Inspector. This position enforces fire prevention regulations of the City of Regina and province of Saskatchewan. Inspectors conduct inspections on all types of new/existing buildings to ensure conformity/compliance with applicable by-laws, codes and regulations, and prepare and present public fire safety education programs.

The knowledge, skill and abilities required are obtained through Grade 12, along with experience as an active firefighter in a career department and courses in IFSAC Certified Fire Inspector NFPA 1031 Level I and II and IFSAC Certified Fire Investigator NFPA 1033. NFPA 1035 Level I and II – Public Fire and Life Educator would be an asset. Knowledge of the various bylaws and regulations under which the Fire Department operates.
