## Criteria for Special Awards

### **Public Education Award**

The Public Education Award may be conferred upon any member of the Fire Service in Saskatchewan who has lent conspicuous service to the furthering of fire prevention education in their community. This person should be a "Champion" of public education not only bringing programs to his or her community but also living as a role model for fire prevention. The nominee should show leadership in the development and presentation of and commitment to public education programs. The nominee will have shown unusual success with existing programs or have developed new programs.

### **Fire Prevention Award**

The Fire Prevention Award may be conferred upon any member of the Fire Service in Saskatchewan who has lent conspicuous service to furthering of Fire Prevention in their community. The nominee will have conducted fire inspection programs or determined cause and origin of fires of unusual circumstances or assisted in the apprehension of arsonists or developed new products or procedures which greatly affect the rate of fire spread or have proposed bylaws which mandate special fire prevention measures. These measures may include such things as residential sprinkler bylaws.

### **Bravery Award**

The Bravery Award may be conferred upon any member of the Saskatchewan Fire Service who, through actions taken at the scene of an incident, went above and beyond the call of duty, risking his/her own life to save the lives of others. This award may be conferred upon an individual or on a team which acted in unison to save the life of a victim of a disaster.

**Commendation Award**

The Commendation Award may be conferred upon a member of the Association who has, through exemplary service, furthered the aims of the Association in their community, regionally, provincially or nationally. This service may be in the form of service on committees, participation in promotional activities, advocacy at various levels of government, forming partnerships, or other such services.

**Nomination Procedure**

The Application form shall be completed in its entirety and signed by two members of the Association. It shall be forwarded to:

The nomination papers must be received by the Executive Director not later than December 31 each year. The Executive Director shall forward copies of all the nomination forms received to the members of the awards committee no later than January 15 and shall add "Awards" to the agenda of the spring Board of Directors Meeting. The members of the Awards Committee shall review the nominations and indicate their recommendation or non-recommendation on the form and fax it to the Chairman of the Awards Committee not less than one week prior to the spring Board of Directors Meeting. The Chairman of the Awards Committee shall propose those nominations which receive Committee recommendation to the Board of Directors at the spring Board of Directors Meeting. The Board of Directors shall vote on each nomination put forward by the Awards Committee. Those receiving the recommendation of the Board of Directors shall be presented a plaque and a certificate at the Annual General Meeting.
